Short Report 2012

Fortunately, we again received many donations from our members, their friends and relatives: over EUR 4,000 from 6 private donors!

Additionally we received another generous donation of EUR 2,500 from "GKV-Bund der Deutschen Krankenkassen" (German national association of statutory health insurance funds) and Eurordis made 2 separate donations totaling EUR 3,600. Taken together with the members' fees, our total income was just over EUR 11,000.

As with other years without a conference, our costs are relatively low so that part of our income can be set aside for future conferences. Last year our costs amounted to EUR 7,400, of which EUR 1,400 was used for participating in meetings of international organizations in our subject area (e.g. Eurordis). Traveling and subsistence costs of the board members for Board meetings amounted to EUR 2,500. In total we were able to save almost EUR 3,000 towards the next conference.

Therefore, our cash resources at the year end were almost EUR 36,000, of which EUR 21,000 are already reserved for the 2014 conference.

At this point, on behalf of The Board, I would like to sincerely thank all donors for their generosity. They allow our Network to continue to support families with a chromosome 11 child. THANK YOU!
